Councillor Stocks thanked the Parish Council, particularly Councillor Jackson, for their support over the past year. 2. Agreement to contribute to the cost of procuring a solar speed sign 3. Currently CWAC is in purdah because of an impending bye election 4. Issues identified with speeding refuse vehicles will be raised with CWAC officers. 5. The proposed changes to and expansion of the Byley gas storage facility have a potentially detrimental impact on the Parish because of the expected increase in vehicle movements. The Peak Cluster project may have similar implications. 6. Reference to the recent decision on the Barn House planning application. 7. CWAC has a £200m highways programme to repair potholes.
